

## DONATION CENTER VOLUNTEER FAQ'S

- Q. What exactly will I be doing when I volunteer in the Donation Center?
- A. You'll be volunteering at one of the stations in our center, helping to quality-check, sort, and package donations for upcoming events where we serve children in need.
- Q. What should I wear?
- A. You should wear something comfortable that you don't mind getting dirty and close-toed shoes.
- Q. What should I bring?
- A. Please bring your own water bottle. If you are volunteering for multiple shifts in a day, you may want to bring a snack.
- Q. Are there age restrictions for volunteering?
- A. Yes, volunteers must be 6 years of age or older. Anyone under 14 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Q. How many people can volunteer at one time?
- A. We allow a variety of different sized groups to volunteer with us. We welcome individuals, families, school and community groups, and corporations.
- Q. How do I get credit for my Community Service hours
- A. For HS students, instructions are available at the center. For all others, please bring your form for your Volunteer Leader to sign at the completion of your shift.

## **When You Arrive**

- Please Park in the middle parking lot. Since our donation center is in a mall, the spaces directly in front of stores are reserved for shoppers.
- We suggest that all volunteers arrive 15 minutes prior to the shift to check in. This will help us ensure that all volunteer shifts begin on time.
- When you enter the building, we will ensure you are registered before you join other volunteers for our shift orientation.
- Your shift will start promptly at your scheduled time and will begin with a brief orientation.
- Following orientation, you will be led to your volunteer station where your Volunteer Leader will provide instructions about your task for the shift. Your Volunteer Leader will be present during the entire shift to answer questions and provide guidance.
